

What Does It Cost To Run Your Lodge / Business?

Assume: Lodge & House

Total Income = \$450,000

Total Expense = \$350,000

Net Profit/Loss = \$100,000 Profit (A GOOD YEAR!)

Assume 3 Year Average Cost of Operating Lodge = \$340,000 (3yr. Average)

Average MONTHLY COST = \$340,000 / 12 months = \$28,333 Monthly

Average WEEKLY COST = \$340,000 / 50 weeks = \$6,800 Weekly

Average DAILY COST = \$340,000 / 350 days = \$971 Daily

Average HOURLY COST = \$971 / 10 H=hours = \$97 Hourly

Use this formula, with variations to calculate the Bar, Dinning Room, Hall Rentals, Lodge Functions and, Overall Lodge cost.
