

2022 ELKS SKILLED TRADE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Maryland, Delaware, and District of Columbia State Elks Association

The Elks Skilled Trade Scholarships are available to Maryland, Delaware, and District of Columbia residents who are planning to pursue vocational/technical training in an accredited post-secondary school.

Who may apply:

- Citizens of the United States
- High School Graduates who have graduated between 2018, and **2021** or will graduate in **2022**.
- The program being pursued must be one that will culminate in a certificate, diploma, or associates degree, but not a bachelor's degree.
(Two -year transfer programs that will eventually culminate in a four-year degree are not eligible.)

The Scholarships:

- The application must be complete, including transcripts and letters of recommendation at the time of submission.
- The Scholarship winners will receive their award for two years. One male and one female will receive \$2,000 per year for two years. Four additional males and four additional females will receive \$1,000 per year for two years.
- The monies are sent directly to the school of enrollment and can be used for tuition, fees, books, and supplies, as well as room and board if the student is living in on-campus housing. The award can only be used toward the expenses of the academic year for which it was intended and not for prior student debts.
- If the student is a second-year student in a two-year program, the award is only for one year.
- Applications are evaluated based on the information contained within the application.

Application Judging:

- Applications will be judged on student goals, grades, extracurricular activities, and letters of recommendation.
- Please make a copy of the completed application for your records.
