Average MONTHLY COST	= \$34(),000 / 12 months	=	<u>\$28,333 Monthly</u>
Average WEEKLY COST =	\$340,0	000 / 50 weeks	=	<u>\$6,800 Weekly</u>
Average DAILY COST = \$3	40,000	/ 350 days	=	<u>\$971 Daily</u>
Average HOURLY COST =	\$971 /	10 H=hours	=	<u>\$97 Hourly</u>
