## What Does It Cost To Run Your Lodge / Business?

| Assume: Lodge \& House |  |  |  |  |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Total Income |  | \$450,000 |  |  |
| Total Expense | = | \$350,000 |  |  |
| Net Profit/Loss | $=$ | \$100,000 Prof |  | (A GOOD YEAR!) |
| Assume 3 Year Average Cost of Operating Lodge |  |  |  | \$340,000 (3yr. Average) |
| Average MONTHLY COST = \$340,000 / 12 months |  |  |  | \$28,333 Monthly |
| Average WEEKLY COST $=\mathbf{\$ 3 4 0 , 0 0 0 / 5 0}$ weeks |  |  |  | \$6,800 Weekly |
| Average DAILY COST $=\mathbf{\$ 3 4 0 , 0 0 0 / 3 5 0}$ days |  |  | $=$ | \$971 Daily |
| Average HOURLY COST = \$971/10 H=hours |  |  |  | \$97 Hourly |

Use this formula, with variations to calculate the Bar, Dinning Room, Hall Rentals, Lodge Functions and, Overall Lodge cost.
